- \* We run 3 official and 1 informal leagues each week.
  - Saturday: 10:30 handicap at Lakeview and 2:00 handicap at Water Tower.
  - Sunday: 10:00 best shot at Water Tower and 2:30 team best shot ("girl golf") at Water Tower.
- \* We run at least 4 main tournaments each year. The Ice Bowl in January, The Springtime Open in March, The World's Biggest in May, and The Fright Feast in November.

# Rules of the Game

One of the most interesting rules of Disc Golf to me is Rule 803.07: Disc Above The Playing Surface. This rule contrasts with ball golf and is one that most beginning disc golfers have a difficult time understanding.

In disc golf, if your disc comes to rest above the playing surface in a tree or other object on the course, the disc is marked directly below the disc on the playing surface. If that point below the disc is out-of-bounds, then your disc is declared out-of-bounds and marked and penalized according to the "out-of-bounds" rules (803.08). (Basically, one penalty stroke and mark the disc up to one meter and perpendicular to the point where the disc last crossed out-of-bounds). If the point directly below the disc is inside a solid object (like a tree), then the disc is marked on the line of play directly behind the solid object.

The tough part of this rule is when the disc comes to rest above two meters of the playing surface (as measured from the lowest part of the disc to the playing surface directly below it). In this instance, there is a penalty stroke assessed and the disc is marked directly below where it came to rest.

If the disc falls, unassisted by player or spectator, to a place less than two meters above the playing surface and before the player arrives at the disc, no penalty is assessed. The player may not delay approaching the disc in hopes that its position improves.

If the two-meter status is uncertain, a majority of players or an official shall make the determination. If the thrower moves the disc before the determination is made, the penalty is applied. If someone other than the player moves the disc before determination is made, no penalty is applied.

Finally, if the disc is above two meters and out-of-bounds, only the out-of-bounds penalty applies.

It seems to me that I've seen video of ball golfers trying to hit balls out of the tree limbs after having climbed into trees after errant golf balls. Maybe it's those same memories that made the PDGA declare elevated discs essentially O.B. ...safety first! Or, it may be the nature of our game. Let's face it, often our "rough" is in the middle of the fairway and 30 feet high. Don't forget, a meter is 3 feet 3 inches. Have fun and good throwin'.

# From the Minds of Tropical Flyers

Rumor has it that the birth of a new course is on the horizon. The Okecheelee Monster is starting to put a scare in golfers on the east coast.

One fine day, three golfers found themselves to each have a day off, so "Used Disc John" Behnstedt, David "Congaman" Vescio, and Janice Harrell (SSP#266) went in search of a new park to find a place to throw where no man or woman had thrown before. We decided to try Okecheelee Park at Forest Hill and the Turnpike in West Palm, south of the airport. Upon arrival, we drove around the hills and did a quick sketch of the place. It looked like a fun place to throw, so we thought we would lay out 18 holes to have somewhere to practice and have some fun!!

We completed the rough loop of 18, and we were stoked. The course had it all – hills, wind, water, and just the right amount of trees. We later found out that this part of the park was opened to automobile traffic only six months prior. Virgin landscape parkland – it's a beautiful thing!

At the moment, we have a well marked object course (you all remember the way you used to play) with the holes flagged with top and bottom tape. Playable maps with distances are available. The course has amateur, advanced, and professional pads that are designed to test the skills of the strong advanced field at 7039 feet.

This is 200 feet longer than the long pad, long pin course at Tradewinds.

Now we come to the "A" pads and the pros. At a healthy 8576 feet, it will be a handful for all but the heartiest of players. Now just remember, this is not a flat course. There are 12 holes with elevation changes, three where water comes into play, and trees on every hole. And by the way, the wind is just as strong as Tradewinds, if not even stronger since most of the course is surrounded by a lake.

# Course Clips

## The Tower Park

Don't you just hate this time of year?? The temperature is down and it's perfect for playing golf, then it gets dark at 5:30pm!!! It just isn't fair. I have been reduced to playing only on the already crowded weekends and with all the leagues going on, there doesn't seem to be enough time to play a relaxed round of golf. Looks like I'll have to quit my job so I can get some more rounds in - right after I win the lottery that is!

Anyway, it's that time of year again, the planning of the Ice Bowl and the Springtime Open tournaments has begun. Ron Tyre has stepped forward to run the Ice Bowl and will need our support to make this fun event run smoothly. Franklin Freedom is helping to raise funds by taking hole sponsorships, and there is a raffle that will be drawn between rounds that will also add to the payout. Please register as soon as you can, because I have a feeling this year may fill up quickly. The field is limited to 90 players, so it won't be too large for us to play and feed everyone in the time allowed. I have started on the 4th Annual Allstate Springtime Open, scheduled for March 18 & 19. Carole Daviau, our favorite insurance agent, Food Committee Chairman, and current club VP, has once again pledged to sponsor the event. She also donated the Tri-state Basket to the raffle to help raise even more funds. Many thanks to her for all she does to support the sport.

The planning of the improvements to the park are progressing very well. Frank Martin and the PIC Committee are doing a fantastic job in dealing with the local government. Four or five meetings to discuss what we (the people who use the park) want, have produced a master plan that is much better than what was put on the table at the beginning. Several compromises and pleasant surprises to the park have been adopted, including the tennis courts being eliminated from the plans, better bridges to cross the ditches, moving the walking path to safer areas, and reclaiming the southwest corner of the park to include use by the golf course.

In a meeting on December 16th with the Parks & Recreation Environmental Review Board, the proposed master plan was submitted by David Johnson and the Planning Dept. Attending the meeting at City Hall was Frank Martin, Jim Widick, and myself as ace reporter. A presentation of the plan with an explanation to the Review Board along with some other suggestions for changes given by Frank, was officially accepted. It looks like the park will get much needed improvements that will not be too intrusive to the golf course and really make it a premier place to go in Sarasota. The PIC Committee deserves a huge thank you for all of their diligence and tireless efforts to make sure the local government does not ruin the golf course while improving the park.

## Lakeview Park

Stardate: 12-18-1999. If this were 5 years ago and you had just told me we would have 2 courses in Sarasota before the year 2000, I'd probably still be laughing. It was New Years Eve 1994 when the practice basket at NWTP was installed, and now our second course at Lakeview Park has 12 Pole Holes plus 6 newly designed "experimental" holes. I say experimental because the holes are short and very tight, with lots of water for discs to go into. They are that way due to the limited area we are allowed to use. I understand that in order to get to 18 total holes, the new ones must be short. This writer would like to see some of the holes dropped to allow for longer holes. A few less but better holes might not be a bad thing. Maybe a redesign of the whole course is in order. This is something for the Competition and Maintenance Committees to address.

Disc Golf in Sarasota has exceeded everyone's expectations of where we would be in 5 short years. It's amazing what the Sky Pilots have done so far and the turn of the millennium is sure to bring even more good things from our great club. Happy Holidays to everyone!!

I have had some layout ideas from the Miniatic (Gregg Hosfeld), Tim Willis, and Jim Widick. Now how about yours?? By the way, my brief visit at Water Tower Park was loads of fun - I felt right at home. Your greeting was very motivating (my hat will never fit over my swelled head!). Many Sarasota-based Sky Pilots attended the 1999 Moccasin Lake Open in Clearwater, FL. Here's my account of the weekend:

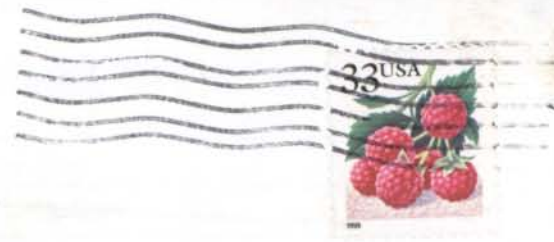

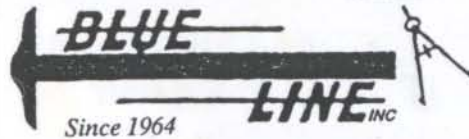
