Dear WFC Competitor:

For the fifth year in succession, the Wham-O World Class Frisbee® disc endorsement program will be related to the results of the World Championships. While there are other methods of selecting endorsement teams, we believe this method to be the most fair and to provide the best stimulus for all players and the sport of Frisbee® disc play in general.

This year's program has been changed from that of last year's in order to offer endorsement opportunities to a greater number of players. The 1979-80 endorsement pool has been increased to a fixed guarantee of \$30,000. The following positions will be invited to participate in the program.
