INTERNATIONAL TEAM AWARD

On the strong performances of Christophe Schott, Peter Jonsson and Agneta Fuglesang, Sweden regained its international WFC award with a 99.69 point total. This score reflects an average of those 3 player's points with Agneta's score being adjusted to match the men's point system. Only teams with at least 2 members were considered for the international team title. Canada showing a strong recovery from their lower finish in WFC '79, finished a close second at 97.94 points largely on the strong consistent play of Gail McColl. England recorded their highest placement in history with a third at 37.32 points. Liz Reeve led the scoring with contributions from Derek Robins and Kevin Walker. In the fourth position was the surprisingly strong team from Australia with 35.72 points. Trailing them were Denmark at 16 points, Japan at 15.83 points, West Germany at 11.75 points and France at 10 points. All of these scores represent the team's average scoring for their top three players adjusted to the men's point scale.

The real story of the international field this year was the incredible development of play in all areas. By next year it is apparent that there will be many international players contending for the top spots in each of the disciplines.

This year's overall winners in the four divisions - Scott Zimmerman, Cyndi Birch, John Pickerill and Ron Widel - accepted the award for the United States. The flag-bestrewn International Trophy went to the Swedish team, which produced a number of semifinalists in various events and an excellent Guts player in Christophe Schott. Third place in the International Team Competition went to Canada, and fourth to the United Kingdom. Good show.
