Kevin is a member of BCF and the International Frisbee Association. He was instrumental in fueling the initial energies that brought competitive and recreational disc play to Sheboygan. Frisbee in Sheboygan got rollin' at a healthy rate during the Bicentennial. An event was planned, promoted, and financed by Kevin Hogan. It was called the "Great Frisbee Flip Out". Its intention was that 1776 Frisbees would be thrown from Kiwanis Hill by 200 different people on the 4th of July, thus signifying the birthday and the 200 years that have elapsed. The event also laid claim to the Wis State Frisbee Championships. They have since been held in Sheboygan every year since then. At that event in 1976 Gordy Johnson put together a list of people who might be interested in joining and forming a Frisbee Club in Sheboygan. 6 months later Bruce Wilk called those people on that list. He and Bill White and the people on the list started playing in the Spring of 1977.
