Did you know???

-That RADL member **Stan McDaniel** was the Masters World Champion!?!?!? (He finished 4th this year.)

-That **Dave Hoover** and **Alan Roberts** were the Amateur Doubles World's Champions?!?!?!?

-RADL **gave** away over 650 discs in 1993 and over 823 discs in 1994!!! Did you get any? It's easy to get yours....All you've gotta do is play golf!!!!!! Can we bust the 1000 disc barrier in 1995? Through the Harvest Tourney we've given away 890 discs!

-Barry 'n Jon's Birthday Bash, July's annual disc party was rumored to be a great tourney. This **phantom** event allegedly had 85 competitors. Legend has it that Brett "Dr. Bones" Hightower drained the \$79.00 ace pool....just before three others dove in! Liz Crowley, Kevin McFadden (PRO), Dary Bryant and Chandler Thompson were the monthly champions (according to popular reports!) Don't miss next year's event!

-The Flight Brothers (Todd & Jim Costen) played host to 60 golfers at the **August Jam!** Larry Leonard cruised to a 9 stroke V in the pros, edging new pro Alan Roberts and the Flying Markov Brothers. Dustin Lynch nipped Daniel Lambeth Jr by 5 for the Junior crown. In the Ladies division it was Michelle Aurilio by 5 over Liz Crowley. Tonya Jasmin, Andrea Hallaman, and Pam Vesper fought it out for third. Richmond's John Biscoe took the Jamateur title, 7 strokes ahead of Chris Rogers. Brian Aurilio, Eddie Knickman, and Ken Jernigan were 4 in back of Chris. In the Advanced division Brian McRee continued his hot play (he placed fifth at the World's this year!) edging Joe Who in a playoff. David Brittle was one back at 98, Dary Bryant was 1 behind "Peanut". Charlie Lochmuller, George Martin, and Jack Beadling were in fifth tied at 100. Jack Beadling cooled off in the ace pool (\$58)!!! This exciting event had 18 closest

to the hole prizes. Larry Leonard, Alan Roberts, Ken Jernigan, Jim : Markov, and Dary Bryant won two apiece! Talk 'bout hot!

-RADL DID YOU KNOW? Did you know that Richard Paschel pocketed \$25.00, the RADL "Bounty" on best amateur MTA toss of the season at Monday evening DDC and all-around frisbee play sessions? Well he did. Rascal tossed a sweet 10.20 second toss.

-The 1995 Amateur North Carolina State Championships only attracted 77 golfers. Dustin Lynch was the Junior state champ, 10 strokes ahead of Daniel Lambeth Jr. Ann Adams captured the Ladies crown, besting Jill Orrison and Andrea Hellaman. Shannon Neely dominated the Amateurs, winning by 12 strokes. Chuck Aiken took second, 1 ahead of James "That's Mr. Pez to You" Peszko and Barrett Panton. Curt Rask was fifth at 219. In Advanced, David Brittle and Bo Butcher fought to a tie with "Peanut" coming out on top of the playoff. George Martin was 5 strokes back at 196. Brian McRee took fourth at 197. Eight strokes back were Charlie Lochmuller and Chris Dickerson who tied for fifth. Where do you find the nation's best amateur golfers? (In Raleigh at the State Championships!)

-The 1995 North Carolina State Flying Disc Championships saw 42 disc players come out to try their hands at five (5) disc events. That's right, this throw-back to yester-year featured disc golf, distance, double disc court, MTA and accuracy. DDC was held on Friday, with six teams showing up to do battle. The team of Dave Hesselberth and Carlton Howard went undefeated in round robin play and Randy Lahm and Shahid Islam lost only once in the route to the finals. Lahm/Islam took game one of the best-of-three championship series only to see Howard/Hesselberth come back to win the championship in front of a spirited gallery on Saturday afternoon. MTA saw Brian Meigs (three-peat) to his third NC State MTA crown...losing a 11.28 in the finals. Phil Pollack (11.09), Alan Beaver (10.92), Dave Hesselberth (10.84), and Larry Leonard (9.86) wound out the top five. Accuracy (four tosses from seven stations) saw an exciting finish as Stan McDaniel and Dave Hesselberth wound up tied after the finals. They had an unusual "alternating throw off" that left Hesselberth the winner. Brad Benton was third, Phil Pollack

was fourth, and Aaron Hayes was fifth completing 33 throws. Distance was awesome to behold as Randy Lahm set a new state record with a monstrous toss of 157 meters (518 feet!). Brian Meigs took second at 146, Dave Hesselberth was third at 129, Walter Haney was fourth at 123, and Steve Millward was fifth also at 123 meters. Golf was only three rounds as Larry Leonard romped to first place with a final round tournament record (breaking Ken Climo's mark) of 15 under. Stan McDaniel was second (9 back) at 135. Walter Haney and Steve Millward tied for third at 139. Randy Lahm finished fifth at 141. In the Master's division it was Alan Beaver by 6 over Perry Hardison at 149. Stew Hubbs finished third at 154, one ahead of Eric Junkin. Keith Whittington finished fifth at 156. Susan Whittington cruised to victory in the Ladies division, besting Michele Aurilio. In the Overall race, Dave Hesselberth edged Randy Lahm by 2 points. Stan McDaniel was third (19 points back) at 40, 1 ahead of Steve Millward. Phil Pollack finished fifth. In Master's Overall it was Alan Beaver all the way, followed by Stew Hubbs, Jim Gaarder, Duke Stableford, Aaron Hayes, Eric Junkin and Keith Whittington. Sue Whittington took the Ladies crown. In Advanced overall it was Dave Brittle by 7 points over Richard Paschal. Dave Mansfield finished third with Tim Thomas taking fourth. Next year's states promises to be even better. Why don't you start practicing those "other" events now....you'll be a much better golfer because of it. Check 'em out! (The word is that MTA and DDC discs are available at special RADL prices. Call CHH.)

-RADL DID YOU KNOW? Did you know that RADL member Chris Hysell got his first Pro PDGA win in 1995? Well he did.

-Kentwood's Disc Terror spooked 72 golfers into rising from the dead and teeing it up. Walter Haney tied CHH and took the brass ring in a playoff that saw CHH almost putt his way to victory. Barry Millward and Pygmy-Man Todd Markov also had a playoff, with Barry getting the nod. Jim Markov finished fifth. JJ Jernigan took Juniors. Joy Cook shot 66, 66 en route to the Ladies lead, nipping Andrea Hallaman. Chris Oschell cruised to the Jamateur victory (after a hot Summer of smokin' doubles), besting Robbie Johnson by 7. Bryan Lemon and Curt Rask were tied for fourth at 102. Brian Aurilio, Brian

Kroll and Chris Duncan tied for fifth at 103. Dangerous Dan Lambeth had the Advanced division "nailed" from start to finish edging David Brittle by 2. Chandler Thompson and Tom Murdick were third at 93. Brian McRee and Greg Maday tied for fifth, one stroke back. Walter Haney **drove** into the ace (\$63) pool just minutes before Dave Brittle cracked his noggin' on the (empty) bottom! Eddie Knickman and Lewis Hoffman captured all the closest to the grave prizes. Ms. Gloria was the key to a fun event. Her assistance made everything groovy!

-The RADL Homecoming, RADL's annual pig pickin' was another fine success. Approximately 50 hungry deuce-meisters gathered for food and fun. The barbecue was great (Clyde Coopers) and we even had pink lemonade!!! Be sure that you don't miss it....next year!

-**The Harvest**, November's Radl event, saw 64 golfers dance through the falling leaves at Cedar Hills. Playoffs were also in the air as Captain Kirk (Yoo) tied CHH and then vanquished him on the first playoff hole. In the Amateur division, it took two holes before Jeff Beddingfield edged Brian Aurilio for the honor of becoming NC's newest advanced golfer. Larry Leonard finished third (in the Pros), 4 strokes behind Kirk and CHH. Jim Markov was fourth at 99, four strokes in front of Alan Roberts. Jack Beadling captured the advanced crown, coming from behind with a hot second round 10 under! Brian Mcree, 2 strokes back in second, edged George Martin also by 2. Dary Bryant and Richard Paschal tied for fourth at an even 100! Mike Haskins, Jim Costen, and Barrett Panton had a three-way tie for third....in the amateur division. Andrea Hallman took the ladies crown, with Sue Whittington playing (pro, open, men's) and taking eighth (out of ten)!!!! Closest-to-the-holes were won by Shannon Stewart, Eric Linney and Chris Kettner. (Thanks to ACE and LCDGA for the donations! Nobody aced so the \$59.00 rolls over to the Kentwood Christmas Classic!!!)

-RADL Random Doubles. The sensational Summer sizzling phenomanon is over! Record turnouts were recorded at both Kentwood and Cedar Hills.

Cedar Hills: After 18 events Larry Leonard led the Pro division (and all others) with 713 points. Jim Markov (581) edged Alan Roberts

(576) for second as Brett Rousseau (496) and Kirk Yoo (436) comprised the rest of the top five. Jack Beadling was the king of the Advanced hill with a total of 625 points, sixteen in front of George Martin. David Brittle and Todd Costen were dead-even at 551. Dary Bryant was in fifth at 516. Chris Rogers (553) spanked the Amateur division, just before returning to Canada. Barrett Panton (541) owned second, thirty-one in front of Mike Mersch. Brian Aurilio was fourth at 497, one ahead of Chris Brannen. Dustin Lynch and Liz Crowley were the Junior and Ladies Champions. Stay tuned for next year. We had 162 competitors during the Summer of '95!

Meanwhile, at Kentwood, Jim Markov was top dawg (Pro) with 953 points, Jon Hardee is 246 back at 707. Kevin McFadden (662) took third as Walter "Mr." Haney (485) edged Larry Leonard (482) for fourth. George Martin (847) was the Advanced division leader with Lee Squires holding down second (754). Joe Who took third at 566. Danny McFadden (498) bested Brian McRee (401) in a retrospective look at the top five. The Jamateur champion was Chandler Thompson (898) with Todd Costen a close second at 851. Chris Oschell edged Shannon Neely (745) for third with a 790 total. Tony Ford nailed down fifth with a 742 total. The ever popular Kentwood Country Club was a consistently big draw....all Summer long. A total of 184 different folks jammed their way to seasonal fun at K-rock! One day 75 folks turned out! Don't miss out. Get out early and often next Spring!

-RADL DID YOU KNOW? Did you know that Kirk Yoo won the most discs (and plaques) on the Piedmont Random Doubles Tour this year??? Well he did. (20 & 3).

-Check out the RADL 1995 Points standings! The way it works is each golfer gets a point for entering a RADL monthly and then additional points for every golfer they beat! After eight events (Ice Bowl, Joe Who, the April Monthly, Hawk's Maypole Jam, June Buggin' Open, August Jam, Kentwood's Disc Terror, and the Harvest Tourney.): Jim Markov leads the Pro division with an awesome total of 587 points. CHH is in second with 387 points, 2 ahead of Will Lewis. Kevin McFadden (378) and Larry Leonard (373) round out the top five.

The Advanced Champion is currently George Martin (498) with Dary Bryant a close second at 487. Dan Lambeth is third at 479. Brian McRee (474) and David Brittle (410) round out the top five. In the Ladies Division Sue Whittington leads the gang with a total of 106 (But she is a Professional and the rest of the Ladies are Ams.). Michelle Aurilio (44) is 3 ahead of Sue DeMarrais (41) Tonya Jasmin (35), Liz Crowley (28), and Becky Manson (23) round out the top five. Ken Jernigan leads ALL Amateur golfers with a total of 260 points. Brian Aurilio (252) is only 8 points back in second place. Lynn Orrison and Jim Costen are tied for third at 232. Eddie Knickman is in fifth place at 224. In the Under-16 division it's Dustin "Tree" Lynch in the lead with 43 total points. Daniel Lambeth Jr. is second at 41, 22 points in front of David Ward. The key to this stuff is playing welland showing up at all the monthlies!

-At this year's Pro Worlds CHH finished in 19th place (his best finish since '87) and Larry Leonard took 21st. Stan McDaniel finished 4th in the Master's Division!!!

-RADL DID YOU KNOW? Did you know that Lance Manson won two ace pools during the Piedmont Random Doubles Tour this Summer??? Well he did, pocketing over \$270.00!!!
