## Course Comparisons

Disc golf season is finally here, and we thought you might like to know how different courses in North Carolina measure up. We've compiled a table of hole distances for all NC courses on which PDGA tournaments are played. As for the long and the short of it, Charlotte's Latta Park (LP) is the longest course at 4843 ft, Burlington's Cedarrock (CR) is next at 4424 ft, and Raleigh's Cedar Hills (CH) and Kentwood (KW) follow at 4300 and 4120 ft, respectively. North Carolina's short courses are Winston-Salem's Horizons Park (HP) and Durham's Cornwallis Road Park (CW) at 3297 and 2896 ft, respectively. The shortest hole is Durham's #4 at 104 ft; longest hole is Charlotte's #1 at 363 ft, which is only a foot longer than #9 at the same course.
