"Country Course" Welcomes Area Disc Golfers

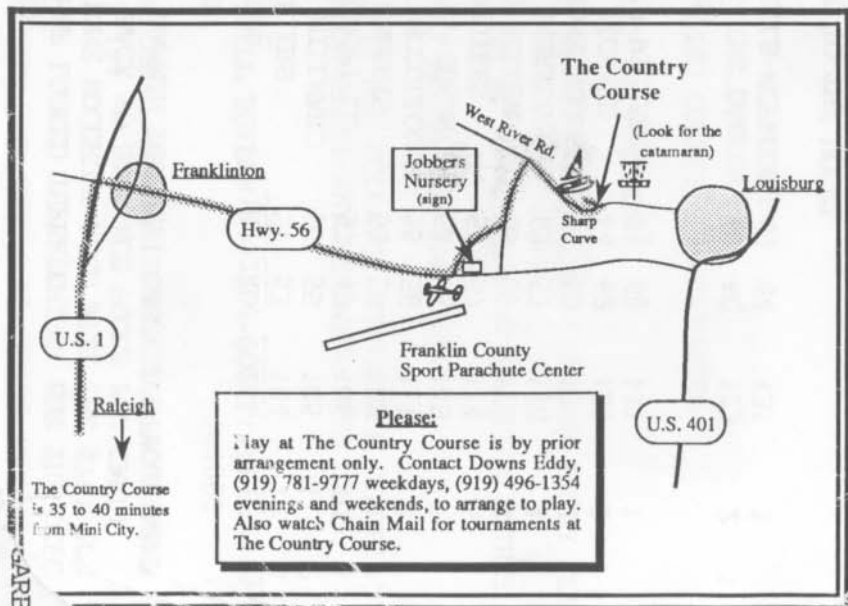
You may have heard of it. A private disc golf course somewhere in the area. Perhaps only a rumor; it was hard to tell. Can it really be, another disc golf course right here in central North Carolina?

Yes! It's The Country Course, near Louisburg, NC, unknown except to a small circle of initiates. Until now. Course owner and superintendent John (call me Downs) Eddy has put out the welcome mat for disc golf junkies in the RADL area.

Downs was introduced to disc golf about a year and a half ago. He became so enthusiastic about the sport that he began making homemade pole holes

from whatever materials were obtainable, in order to practice. One thing led to another, and by summer 1989 an 18-hole course had been laid out. In its current configuration, the Country Course is more than 4200 feet long, half homemade pole holes and half objects. It has a good mix of short "finesse" holes and long open "crank" holes.

During the summer, the Country Course will host occasional informal get-togethers. As plans materialize, we'll get word around. In the meantime, anyone is welcome to come and play. Just contact Downs to make arrangements.
