Underneath a grey canopy of clouds which threatened drizzle throughout the day, La Mirada drew 143 disc golfers old and new to play in the first worldwide disc golf tournament ever held, the World's Biggest Disc Golf Tournament. Held on Saturday, May 9 at over two hundred courses in more than a dozen countries, the WBDGT was intended by promoter John Houck to increase the exposure of the sport in a friendly, supportive environment. That's exactly what happened on Saturday.

(Good going, John. Despite the work and the anxiety, I'm more than glad to have been a part of it and I am looking forward to next year.)

The positive attitudes of both the newcomers and the regular players was extremely encouraging. By 7:00 a.m. two players that I was meeting for the first time had showed up early to warm up; instead of going out to practice immediately they helped me set up the tables and the banner. Tim Biffle, the heart and most of the hands of course maintenance, arrived at 7:30 to move some baskets and help put up signs. Also arriving early with offers to help were Dennis Gordon and Kay; her help with the distribution of the packages kept the check-in process on this side of chaos.

With few exceptions the players too were patient and supportive, despite occasional delays and miscues and the fact that all hundred packages were gone by 10:30. One encouraging sign was that about 3/4 of the fifty or so unregistered players who walked up after there were no more packages chose to sign up and wait for them. (The last batch hit the mail on 5/19.) Obviously, the lack of pressure to perform and the generous package went a long way toward keeping everyone relaxed and happy.

The presence of a large group of barbecue lovers loosely associated with Wham-O was a special treat. A spontaneous game of ultimate even broke out in mid-afternoon.

I learned a lot running this thing, most of all that it was worth all the trouble. If you have any comments or suggestions, let me know. See you (and your friends) next year!
