

THE COMPLETE SPIN—BLOG SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The FDM created the blog feature to provide a platform for our patrons to share an expanded look at the history of specific flying discs, manufacturers, players, collectors, event history, etc.

STYLE GUIDELINES

These style guidelines are general in nature, but we ask you to adhere to them as much as possible:

- Should be written in 3rd person, unless it is a 1st person account
- Length should generally be between 500 and 2,000 words
- Please include references to source information when available
- Articles can include relevant links that support the article's principal subject matter
- Photos and video links are acceptable if they directly support the article's content

CONTENT GUIDELINES

The following content guidelines are also general in nature. The FDM reserves the right to reject any submissions that do not reflect the overall spirit of the museum and/or these guidelines.

Submit articles that pertain to:

- A flying disc collectible or group of collectibles
- A flying disc event that relates to a particular disc or series of discs or collectibles
- A flying disc accomplishment, especially one relating to a particular flying disc or group of discs, devices, innovations, etc.
- A flying disc inventor, innovator or other disc sports "game changer"
- A collector, player, enthusiast or other person/animal of flying disc-related significance
- Anything germane to the art of making, designing or hot stamping a disc or disc series

[If you have an idea that doesn't fit in any of the above topical areas, but you feel is of interest and worthy of inclusion, please contact the FDM for its consideration.]

SUBMISSION

Once you have completed your article, please submit it to info@flyingdiscmuseum.com for review. Any appropriate images, photos, links, or charts should be sent as separate attachments along with instructions indicating where in the document they should be placed. FDM gallery photos can also be included in your article or referenced with links to them. Simply indicate the gallery and photo number, where it should appear in your article, and if it requires a caption.

Please include a brief (50 word) bio for inclusion in an "About the Author" footer. It can be serious, funny, whimsical, whatever you want. Also, please include a head shot photo—an informal picture is fine.

We will confirm receipt of your article and let you know of any questions, concerns or potential edits. Your article will be put in the queue and will be published in the order it was received.

Blog submissions earn one credit towards the FDM recognition program for each 500 words written (republishing of previous work does not qualify).
