Contribution Rules and Guidelines

All contributors must agree to following the rules and guidelines listed below. Again, this is to assure the quality and consistency standards of the Museum continue to be met as it grows.

- 1) Contributors stipulate that the photographs uploaded are their own, that they own the copyright or otherwise have the legal right to grant use of the photograph. Note that contributors do not necessarily need to own the disc or other item pictured.
- 2) By uploading photographic images and information to the Flying Disc Museum, contributors give the Museum the legal right to display those images and information to the public. Once an image is uploaded, it can only be removed or replaced at the sole discretion of the Museum.
- 3) Contributors agree to follow the Museum's photography guidelines to the best of their ability (see *Standard Requirements for Photo Submissions* and *Photographing Flying Discs*).
- 4) Contributors agree to complete all the pertinent information and follow the syntax guidelines required for the titles and descriptions/captions of contributed photographs (see *Quick Reference Style Guide—Photo Titles and Caption Descriptions*).
- 5) Contributors agree to follow language guidelines as set forth in the Museum's *Glossary and Acronym Guide*.
- 6) Contributors agree that any comments made in the Special Notes section of disc descriptive information can be substantiated by a source.
- 7) The Museum will not use photos for any purpose other than display without the owner's explicit consent, and has attempted to block the unauthorized use of any photos. However, there is no guarantee that unauthorized copies or use will not occur.
