NEWS IN THE AIR

A demonstration of Disc Golf will be given for the Walk Against Drugs at Boone Woods on Saturday May 13. Kerry Keith is in charge of the demonstration and would appreciate any help from club members on that date. This is an opportunity to publicize our sport and our club, so please help out.

The Edgewood Electric Open is quickly approaching and the valued services of our membership is again needed. Please contact Tournament Director Kerry Keith if you can assist June 3-4. The tournament will be held at Cincinnati Recreation Commission's Mt. Airy Forest. We need a very successful event because of the need to show the park board the value of Disc Golf in the hopes of the installation of a new course at Mt. Airy. A new course would provide the residents of Cincinnati with better access to our lifelong fitness sport.

The "away" half of the Cincinnati-Dayton challenge was played at Dayton's newly remodeled Eastwood Park on April 16. This match resulted in the first ever loss by the Cincinnati team. We won the initial round of play last year at Banklick Woods, but were defeated in a sudden life playoff. Since each team won at home, it is hoped that a neutral ground playoff will be held, possibly at Miami University's excellent nine hole course.

Two corrections to last issue's tournament results: Brent Hambrick won the Boone Woods Disc World open, not Brent Newport as reported, and the Mt. Airy course record belongs to Tom Robison, not Mark Holland.
