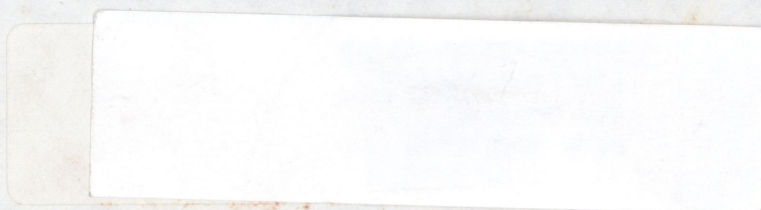

The Ice Bowl commeth!

The first local tournament of 1990, the Ice Bowl, will be held on January 6. The location is yet to be determined, but there is discussion of setting up a temporary course on the ball golf course at Shawnee Overlook Park. Kerry Keith, who did a great job running the 1989 Edgewood Electric Open, has volunteered to be the tournament director.

The Ice Bowl is a national event, with different cities across the country holding their own tournaments. It is a PDGA sanctioned event, so there are **points awarded toward qualifying for the 1990 World Championships**. Sure, you've got to be a little crazy to want to play with frozen hands, but most golfies are getting a little stir crazy by then anyway!

Watch for further announcements from the club as time for the tourney approaches. For more information, you can call a club officer (listed on the back of this newsletter), or call Kerry at 662-8601.

Another logo design contest for the artful disc tossers . . .

Actually, there are two contests, but there may be one winner. The main contest is to design a logo for the Edgewood Electric Open Disc Golf Tournament, to be held the first weekend in June. The club purchases discs and minis with the tournament logo stamped on them to sell at the tournament and to give to participants in the players' package. If the logo for the tournament is really hot, the club might use it to replace the winged disc we currently use.

The winning artist will receive free entry into the tournament, including the players' package.

Entries must be received by one of the club officers by **January 31, 1990** to allow time to convert the design idea to camera ready artwork for printing. (That means your idea doesn't have to be perfectly drawn . . . just give us something to work with!)

Membership renewals due in January!!

Unless you joined the club after October 1, 1989, you will need to renew your membership at the beginning of 1990. The officers and any members present will be discussing the dues rate and what should be provided in consideration for payment of dues. If you have any ideas, suggestions or opinions in this area, please attend the meeting to voice them, or contact an officer before the meeting to make your wishes known.
