Spring league dates set: can circular skies be far behind?

Teresa Keith, head of the league committee, has published the dates and fees for the spring leagues, and her "right hand", Kerry, has already distributed a flyer with that information to many of you. For those who are hibernating, here's the scoop:

MIXED COUPLES LEAGUE --

- Who:** Anyone who enjoys golf -- this is a relaxed, social league
- What:** Best disc played with teams consisting of one male, one female
- When:** Tuesday nights, beginning April 3, 6:15 -- 8 weeks
- Fee:** \$16.00/team (find your own partner) -- **PAY BY MARCH 25**
- Prizes:** Draw for goodies at party after league ends

HANDICAP LEAGUE --

- Who:** Competitive golfers -- this is for points earned toward awards
- What:** Teams are created by handicapping players by average score for 18 holes of golf. Players throw from their own lies (standard golf). Each week different teams are scheduled to play one another, and players/teams are awarded points based on holes "won" from the opposing player.
- When:** Wednesday nights, beginning April 4, 6:15-- 8 weeks
- Fee:** \$12.00/person (\$11.00 for GCFDA members) -- **BY 3/25**
- Prizes:** Trophies to 1st, 2nd, 3rd place teams, best average, high points
Awarded at party after league ends

PRO LEAGUE --

- Who:** People who will only play for money!
- What:** Best disc -- bring your own partner
- When:** Thursday nights, beginning April 5, 6:15-- 8 weeks
- Fee:** \$30.00/team -- **PAY BY MARCH 25**
- Prizes:** 95% payback to 1st place team only, no party

SIGN UP AND SCORE ESTABLISHMENT --

- Who:** Mandatory for anyone who has not played in a league,
Fun and good practice for everyone else!
- What:** Two 18-hole rounds of golf, scored by another person
- When:** Sunday, March 25 -- 1:00 p.m.
- Where:** Boone Woods DGC

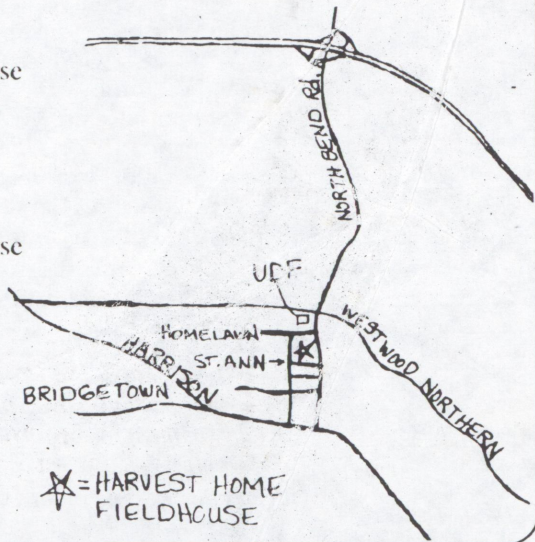
We hope that there will be a good turn out for the Wednesday night league this spring. Mark Holland is working on a handicapping system which will take into account the distance of the courses, so that the handicap will be different for the more difficult courses. (Ball golf courses are "rated" for this purpose.) The hope is that this handicapping system will make the teams more equal, and thereby make the competition more interesting for players of all levels -- everyone should have an equal chance at winning the league. If there are at least 10 teams, the league will be split into "A" and "B" flights, as in the past. Help support the leagues and get some golf buddies to participate!
