LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT:"State of the Club Address"

Greetings to all members and friends. The Philadelphia Frisbee Club is now a little over two (2) years old, having started in January of 1977. The Club membership has risen and dropped, from 2 in January, 1977 to over 150 last summer and now back down to 16 at the present. All P.F.C. memberships expire on May 15 of every year, in order to keep our membership current. Therefore, if you haven't renewed this may well be your last newsletter. The last being partially financed by the membership dues.

The P.F.C. has taken on several ambitious projects in it's short history, some of these are as follows:

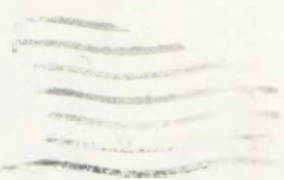
