

POSTAL FLYING DISC CATALOGUE V
Summer Solstice 1977

Dear Friends,

The Atelier seems to be very much on a solar schedule; every time a solstice rolls around a new catalogue rolls off the presses. Credits are due Messrs Pierce, McRann, V. James and Eberle for their recent researches into discal history. Hopefully our hobby will grow sufficiently to sometime in the near future justify the effort of a full scale collecting guide. I suspect that we might all be able to contribute to and gain from such a project. Don Pierce has the Pro, Moonlighter, All American, Fastback and All Star down cold. V. James is hard at work on the sticky matter of the Flying Saucer - Regular chronology as well as the previously understudied Empire and Premier products. Also to V. James, a nod for what is unquestionably the most handsomely printed disc catalogue to date. Now if we could just get Hanaki to write something on the Super Pro - 141G and Rand to write something on Masters and.....

Three of the items which appear below are in need of textual amplification. The Luklif Magic Saucers (138-141 & 376) were found in the original shipping cartons recently at a bay area swap meet. The discs are double-sided and made from formed sheet, not injection molded. They come in four colours and are poly bagged with a paper header. Each disc has two decals on the upper surface, handpainted portholes and handpainted arcuate vanes on the underside. They would seem to be from the early or middle fifties, judging by the graphics and the retail price of 59¢ as it compares to what went into their manufacture. They are 9 1/2" in diameter. I have written to the appropriate chamber of commerce and fictitious names bureau in order to learn more, especially accurate dating, but have as yet received no reply.

The second disc is at least equally valuable as a playing item as it is a collecting one. This is the "Ariel" Sky Surfer gyroplane moulded disc. That's quite a mouthful but that's what the manufacturer calls it. These are English copies of the Super Pro, only they perform much better. They are blue in colour, 9 7/8" in diameter and weigh in around 132 g. Appearance is very G-series with crownless, puddleless design, ridges (yes ridges!) level with the shoulder, no topside engraving but injected from the top instead of the bottom as are true G-series discs. Flight is perfectly stable yet very inflection prone. Material is slightly soft to the touch but in practice not the least bit floppy. Three hundred Surfers are scheduled to arrive from England in the latter portion of August and will probably be all gone by mid-September. They can be reserved by ordering now with delivery in August-- September. This is one of the finest performing discs I have ever thrown. (170-172)

Yankee Doodle Flying Saucer is the third disc. These are the red and blue knockoffs of 1196.'s so many of us have seen around. They were listed as #461 in PFDC IV. At first they seemed to be a Buycentennial item but new shipments have arrived in stores this Spring so we can only assume that they will continue to be offered. It is surprising that Wham-o has not been able to stop them as yet. Manufacturer is still unknown. Should anyone learn more of this disc I would appreciate hearing from you. The Doodle is # 330-339.
