A Word About All Star Production

The All Star first appeared in the winter of 1971-1972. It is made from a twin cavity tool which lacks mold numbers. On one mold there is a faint ring on the underside of the crown just inboard of where it joins the crown-scarp. Discs made in this cavity are called "ringed". The other cavity lacks this feature and plates moulded in it are said to be "ringless". All Star production is not changed each calendar year like that of some other manufacturers instead collectors have noted "periods" which correspond to production runs or tooling changes. The first three of these are easy to identify because of tooling changes. The remainder are merely different production runs. Some collectors do not recognize these as true "periods." They are found here as periods four through seven. Don Pierce developed a method of differentiating between the different runs by charting small marks on the lower half of the tool.
